

OUTLINE OF APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 2. You can obtain a prospectus and application form by downloading it online from our website or by post.
- 3. The completed application form with the relevant application fee should be returned in good time to the College.
- 4. Enclose your two passport photographs, copies of your original educational qualifications, where applicable proof of funds.
- 5. A non-refundable registration fee of £50 is payable at the time of returning the completed application form.



APPLICATION PROCEDURES

The most important entrance requirements for any course with the Bible College are a deep desire and firm commitment to be trained for God's service.

CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

Courses are open for students:

- 1. Age 18 years and above
- 2. Who are practicing Christians
- 3. With a propensity to learn
- 4. Wishing to explore their faith
- 5. Preparing for ordination
- 6. Who demonstrates an ability to pursue academic studies at higher level of education (this will be an advantage)
- 7. Who wish to pursue a qualification in theological studies.

Prior to admission students may be required to attend an informal interview and references will be required from their church leaders.

2. DIPLOMA IN APPLIED THEOLOGY AND MINSTRY

Students must successfully complete the Certificate 1 level course before proceeding to Diploma level or have equivalent qualification. This course builds on the theoretical foundation of Certificate level course and aims at:
